INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

Article 1

- 1) The Rulebook on Register of Members on power exchange market (hereinafter “Rulebook”) determines the procedure and manner of establishing and maintaining the register of Members on the power exchange market (hereinafter “register”), entry and deletion from the register.
- 2) The Market Surveillance Office establishes and maintains the register, performs professional, administrative-technical, material-financial and other tasks related to the establishment and maintenance of the register.
- 3) The register is kept in electronic and written form and is kept as a permanent document.

ENTRY IN THE REGISTER

Article 2

- 1) Entry in the register is performed upon personal request by filling in the Application for the Membership.
- 2) Based on the data given in the Application for the Membership, the person who keeps the electronic register prepares a card of the Member where he/she enters the data from the application, the date of entry, the mark and the number from the register.
- 3) The person who keeps the register forms the file of the Member in written form which is kept as a permanent document.
- 4) Members are obliged to report any change in relation to the data entered in the register to the Market Surveillance Office immediately after its occurrence.

FULFILMENT OF THE CONDITIONS

Article 3

- 1) Upon Receipt of the Application for the Membership, the Market Surveillance Office shall submit to the applicant the following documents:
 - a) Membership Agreement
 - b) Annex 1 – Selection of MEPX markets and authorisations.
- 2) Upon signing the Membership Agreement and fulfilment of Annex 1, the applicant is invoiced for Entrance Fee, Annual Membership Fee and Annual Technical Fee, according to Fee Schedule.
- 3) The applicant shall submit proof of payment upon realization of the payment of invoiced fees.
- 4) After determining the fulfilment of the conditions, MEPX issues a confirmation on entry in register.

DELETION FROM THE REGISTER

Article 4

- 1) The participation in the power exchange market ceases by deleting the Member from the register.
- 2) Deletion from the register may occur in the following cases:
 - a) At the personal request of the Member;
 - b) On the basis of a severe breach of obligations;
 - c) On the basis of a final judgment of the competent court prohibiting performance of activities.
- 3) If the Member who has been deleted from the register wants to renew the membership on the power exchange market, it has the obligation to re-fulfil the registration procedure.
